As a result, she intends to continue working as she always has, maintaining the successful operations she has established.

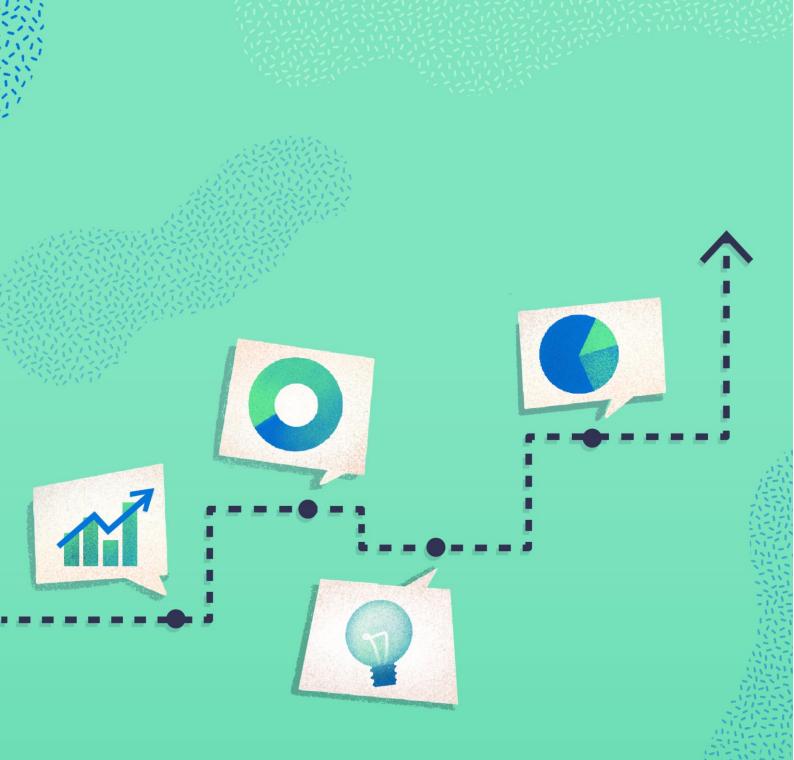
